Scholarships

\$1,000 Scholarship for first-time study abroad students

 Application required. Students should articulate the value of a study abroad experience to their MBA experience and career aspirations and identify the skills they intend to develop during the program.

*"First-time study abroad students" is defined as students who did not participate in a study abroad program during their undergraduate or previous graduate studies

Scholarship applications will open on October 27th. The application deadline is November 15th.

Stipends - Liaison Roles

\$1,500 Stipend for the students selected to be OPERATIONS LIAISONS

- Build your resume with a student leadership position. Practice skills in logistics, planning, and management.
- Work with the faculty, program partners, and CGB on the organization and logistics of the program.
- Requirements: Strong communication skills, attention to detail, leadership and motivation, and organizational skills.

\$1,500 Stipend for students selected to be the COMMUNICATION LIAISONS

- Build your resume with a student leadership position. Practice skills in marketing, communication, and writing.
- Work with faculty, peers, and CGB on communicating the value of the program, capturing the participant journey through a news story, social media, and student highlights.
- Requirements: Creativity, strong writing skills, an artistic eye, and a strong knowledge of the learning objectives of the program.

Stipend applications will open on October 27th. The best consideration deadline is January 10.

Cost

4 credits of tuition + \$2,900 program fee + Education Abroad fee (\$250) + international health insurance fee (\$39)

- Tuition fees cover curriculum development and teaching costs.
- Program fee covers program logistics (shared accommodation, in-country ground transportation, some group meals, business visits, applied learning component, in-country COVID precautions and pre-return testing, and included cultural activities).
- Education Abroad fee covers risk management and program administration.
- All students and faculty participating in UMD sponsored study abroad programs are automatically enrolled in the UMD's international health insurance plan.
