Cheating

- Unauthorized use of external materials to complete work
- Collaborating on assignments without permission

Plagiarism

- Presenting someone else's words as your own
- Not properly citing research

Self-Plagiarism

- Reusing work you have previously turned in
- This includes if you're retaking a course or if two courses have similar assignments

Facilitation

- Intentionally assisting someone else in academic dishonesty
- Giving test answers, posting graded assignments, completing another student's work

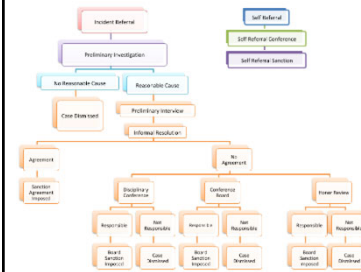

- Falsifying or creating information on an assignment and passing it off as accurate
